Monday January 23

- Students will be instructed to take materials home and to discuss their elective choices with their parents/guardians. Parents have to sign off before course selections will be entered.

Catholic Schools Week - Dress up Days

Monday, January 30—Pajama/Comfy Day

Pick a friend or two and dress like twins. Jeans will be allowed as long as they are neat and clean; hemmed and appropriately fitting with no holes, frays, rips, cut-off or torn. Undergarments must not be visible. The best dressed "twins" will received a special prize from Mr. Delikowski.

Friday, February 3 – All NCS Spirit Day

Students may wear their Newman spirit wear or red, white and blue apparel.
