Science Lab Renovated at Newman

Four years ago, Newman Catholic High School began the process of reviewing their science program in order to ensure the students were receiving a quality, rigorous science

education. As a result, of that study the department and administration identified one key area of improvement: the need to renovate the NCHS Science Lab. The reality was that the lab had not had any renovations since 1955. The team felt that the school could dramatically enhance science education at the high school by installing new lab stations, a pass-thru fume hood, and contemporary lab equipment. Last May, the Newman Catholic Schools System engaged in a capital campaign in which part of the money raised would renovate the science lab. As a result of the campaign, last spring 2008, NCS obtained the donations needed to begin the project.

The lab construction work started last August 2008 with the deconstruction and removal of the old lab stations and cabinetry. The work continued with asbestos abatement, new flooring, and additional renovations. By October, the new lab stations were being installed and the lab began to take on its new look. The final touch was the addition of new energy efficient windows.

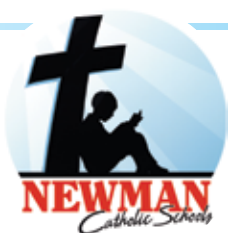
NCHS students and the NCHS science program have already been positively impacted by the renovations.

Currently, 100% of Newman Catholic High School students take three years of science. Course enrollments for the graduating class of 2010 estimate that 85% of the juniors plan on taking four years of science and 40% actually "doubling up" on science their senior year.

Newman Catholic High School currently staffs three science teachers who hold master degrees and specialize in either life sciences, physics, or chemistry.

Dedication and blessing of the new lab was held Sunday, January 25, 2009, with a community open house and science fair following the kick off Newman Catholic Schools Catholic Schools Week celebration.

Bishop ListECKI visited the lab on Thursday, January 29, after celebrating Mass with a packed gym of students, staff and parents of Newman Catholic Schools. Special guests, students and staff of St. Mary's of Marathon, WI were also present for the special liturgy. *

OUR MISSION

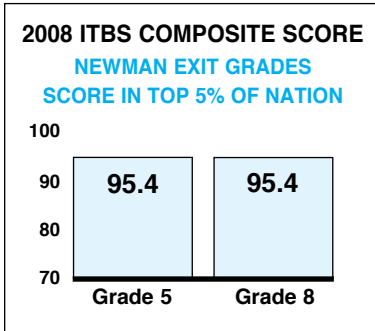
We, the Newman Catholic Schools provide excellence in education in a Catholic environment and enhance the personal and spiritual growth of our students to meet life's challenges.

Tradition of Academic Success Continues

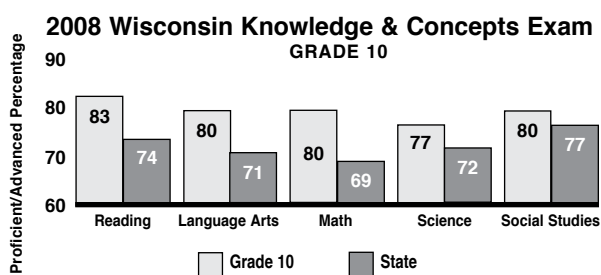
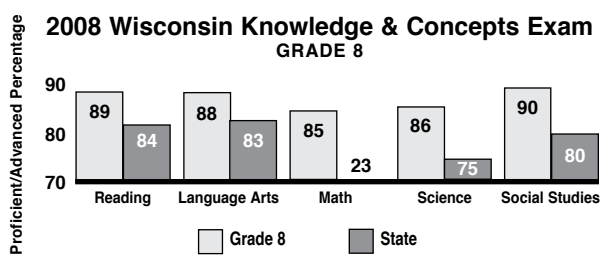


2008 National Standardized test scores confirm that students at Newman Catholic Schools continue the tradition of achieving outstanding academic success. During the 2007-2008 school year students in Grades 2-8 were administered a national standardized test, Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS). Students are tested on knowledge of reading, language arts, mathematics, social studies, science and basic study skills. Newman Catholic Schools has scored well above the 90th percentile in most cases. NCS educators use the results to evaluate the current curriculum and plan for future instruction both for large group and individual

students. Parents are given test results in the spring along with information regarding interpretation and suggestions for future student academic growth. This year's results continue to show improvement over past years. Recent curriculum improvements have been made in Science and Reading instruction and new instructional materials including texts have helped our students make academic advances.

Wisconsin Knowledge & Concepts Exam (WKCE)

In addition to the ITBS, students in Grade 8 and 10 also participate in the Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts Exam (WKCE). The WKCE assessment is required in Wisconsin public schools. Although it is not a requirement for Wisconsin private and religious schools, Newman Catholic Schools has elected to administer this assessment to its students for the purpose of continuing to assess the effectiveness of its curriculum and the overall performance of the schools as



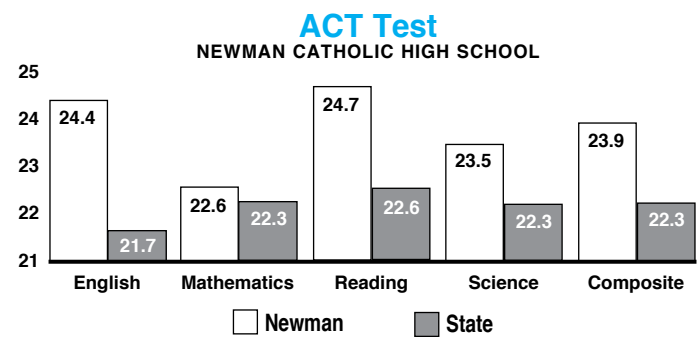
compared to local and state schools. Newman Catholic middle school and high school students continue to score well above their local peers.

Junior Level School PSAT

Junior level students are administered the PSAT, a nationally recognized assessment that is used to evaluate students as it relates to college preparation. The PSAT assists students in planning for college admission and is part of the National Merit Scholarship program. High performing students may be invited to apply for a national scholarship.

High School ACT Test Results

As students proceed through their junior year of high school and early senior year, they are encouraged to take the ACT test as part of the requirements for admission to institutions of higher education. Beginning with the 2007-2008 year, junior level students received instruction regarding ACT test taking strategies as part of the regular curriculum. Throughout Newman's history, it has stood out academically as a school with high performing students, and the 2008 ACT scores once again confirm Newman Catholic High Schools commitment to academic excellence. Our graduating students have scores significantly above their local, state and national peers. Also of special note is that 100% of the students have chosen to take this optional test. It reflects shared commitment by the school and its students to solid preparation for post-secondary educational options.



NCHS Recognizes FOUR AP Scholars

Each year the College Board recognizes students who have earned outstanding achievement on three or more AP tests. Newman Catholic High School's graduating class of 2008 had four students earn the recognition of AP Scholar and AP Scholar with Honors. Only 18% of all the students worldwide taking AP tests earn these recognitions. Last year's AP Scholars included **Anna Luetmer**, **Val Schuster**, and **Ann Henry**. These three students scored a 3 or higher on three AP exams. **Alfonse Drechsler** qualified for the AP Scholar with Honors Award by scoring a 3 or higher on four or more exams. Congratulations to these students for their outstanding academic accomplishments.

Achievements in Literacy Staff Development

There is an adage that says that "You get what you pay for." In recent years, free literacy workshops given in the Wausau Area by Sue Barton have disproved the adage. The Barton literacy workshops were attended by many Newman Catholic School (NCS) teachers. The teachers learned the definition of dyslexia, how to identify children who have this learning concern and how to help these children to become successful students and high-functioning adults.

The educators' enthusiasm for what they learned was shared with the administrative team of the Newman Catholic School System. In the summer of 2007, Mrs. Bernie Heindl and Mrs. Amy Marquardt, both first grade teachers at Newman Catholic Schools, along with reading teacher Mrs. Cindy Wanserski, attended a week-long training on the Barton System in San Francisco. Since the training they have given multiple workshops to other Newman Catholic School teachers to share this knowledge.

The educators learned that dyslexia is not simply reading or writing backward. It is a disorder that originates in the brain and is caused by one section of the brain being oversized. This physical abnormality causes young children to say "aminal" rather than "animal" and "bisghetti" rather than "spaghetti". These children struggle learning to tie shoes. They exhibit dysgraphia, which is the inability to form letters correctly and place them in the correct space on lined paper. The organizational skills of the dyslexic children are minimal. Their bedroom, backpack and desk are in disarray. A person with dyslexia will often work off of piles or have a very disorganized garage as an adult because they find they cannot locate items that are put away. Learning to read, spell and memorize math facts is most difficult because of the way the brain functions. Most common reading remediation methods will

not help dyslexic children. The Barton Program, which is based on the Orton-Gillingham approach to reading, has shown to be a successful method of instruction for this learning concern.

Newman Catholic School teachers have learned in the workshops that children with dyslexia can be successful learners if some accommodations are made in the classroom. These children possess an average or above ability level according to research shared by Mrs. Heindl, Mrs. Marquardt and Mrs. Wanserski. They soon recognize that other children appear to learn easier than they do. Teachers, therefore, need to help the children with this concern to be successful learners so they do not lose their positive self-esteem. The teachers have learned that not calling on children unless they volunteer, not making children write on the board in front of the class, and grading papers on the thought content rather than the spelling or writing mechanics are strategies that build confidence and success for students with dyslexia. Having someone read material to the children or using recordings rather than having them reading everything on their own, and not grading spelling tests or giving limited words on each spelling test also have been shown to be beneficial. Teachers have learned that these children benefit from a reading instruction method that teaches them to isolate sounds so they hear each part of the word they are studying and then systematically practice blending sounds to form words. Mrs. Heindl, Mrs. Marquardt and Mrs. Wanserski have shared methods of using tactile (touching) and visual clues to assist children with learning vowels, consonants and blended sounds. The NCS teachers have learned that there are spelling rules that make spelling much easier to learn. The teachers have learned that simple tools, such as an electronic spell checker, make a tremendous difference in the children's academic accomplishments.

Mrs. Marquardt says, "Newman Catholic School teachers are learning skills at the Barton workshops that not only help the students with dyslexia, but all students who are emergent learners."

Elementary Spanish Program

World Language Instruction has begun a part of the curriculum at the elementary level at Newman Catholic Schools. Surveys of classroom teachers determined that teaching cultural diversity and a foreign language at the elementary level was an important component of the school improvement process. During the 2006-07 school year NCS formed a parent and staff committee to study this issue. The committee studied world language research, established the need to teach about multiple cultures, decided that teaching Spanish in the elementary schools was viable, established a process for implementing Spanish instruction and sought out funding for the program. In the Fall of 2007 the curriculum for the elementary Spanish program was written and approved. As a result of the committee work, Spanish instruction began in March 2008 for the Kindergarten to Grade 5 in the NCS classrooms.

Senora Patricia Cicha was hired to teach Spanish in the elementary schools. Patricia is a native Spanish speaker who has used her bilingual skills as a teacher, tutor, interpreter and media and court translator. Patricia studied abroad through the Universidad Autonoma de Mexico. She received her bachelor degree at Northern Illinois University and her masters at Texas A & M International University.

Senora Cicha will visit each Kindergarten to Grade 5 classroom on a weekly basis. In order to make this experience the most beneficial for the students, classroom teachers will participate in the Spanish instruction time. Spanish lessons will be reinforced as the teachers and students use the Spanish language to greet each other and as the curriculum of other subject is taught. For example, they will use Spanish color names during art projects, Spanish number names in math, and give common directions in Spanish. Specialists, preschool teachers, child-care providers and other staff members are encouraged to use Spanish that they may know or seek out information that could be included as they work with students. Elementary schools are incorporating Spanish cultural activities as well as those of other countries into their school activities.

NCS – ‘We Belong to Christ’ Capital Campaign

At Newman Catholic Schools, we are thankful for our many blessings. We know that all we are able to accomplish is due to the generous support of our parishes, parents, alumni and community. Last spring we embarked on a much needed and much anticipated capital campaign, the ‘We Belong to Christ’ campaign, held in conjunction with an all-Catholic parish’s campaign designed by the Diocese of La Crosse.

The three areas of need identified by Newman Catholic Schools were to renovate the NCHS Science Lab/Classroom to provide state-of-the-art academic opportunities; finish replacing windows/HVAC; renovate high school athletic fields; and eliminate debt to the Diocese.

The ‘We Belong to Christ’ campaign addresses all three of these areas. Our campaign will utilize two-thirds of the funds for repairs and upgrades to Newman Catholic High School, with the remaining one third applied to debt reduction. The total combined goal of the local parishes and NCS ‘We Belong to Christ’ campaign for Newman Catholic Schools is \$4.45 million. To date approximately \$2.2 million has been pledged toward this goal.

Last August renovation work

began on the Science Lab and classroom at Newman Catholic High School. In October, new HVAC, flooring, baseboards, plumbing, electrical, painting, lighting and suspended ceilings were added. By the end of October,

windows were installed in the lab/classroom as well as in three additional classrooms, hallway and technology work area.

What a tremendous change for our students. Thanks to our donors, many contractors, and staff for making this possible! Our hats off to everyone who has helped get the new NCHS science lab up and running! One project complete, but we are not done!

An additional \$600,000 in pledges and cash (\$200,000) is needed to fund the first phase of the athletic field renovations. We would like to begin work this spring on relocation and renovation of the football field/track, soccer field and the baseball practice field. Additionally, approval has been given by Bishop Jerome ListECKI to study the cost estimates and available support for new tennis courts on the corner property of Bridge Street and Stevens Drive. However, this project was not part of the first phase of the athletic field renovations of the campaign and will be handled through a separate process in order to be approved and completed.

For over fifty years, Newman

Catholic High School has played an important and integral role in educating youth in the greater Wausau area. Standing steadfast and proud along Bridge Street, the buildings, it’s graduates, and current students represent a part of Wausau’s Catholic identity that has positively touched all of our lives. The greater Wausau area is a community with many Catholic Parishes and parishioners, but with one Catholic High School. This is our High School to celebrate, to be proud of and to support. It is with this sense of responsibility, history and pride that we launched this pivotal campaign. This is an exciting moment of revitalization and resurgence guaranteeing the influence of Catholic High School education will continue to positively influence our local Catholic youth.

Newman Catholic Schools has a great foundation and now is the time to build on that foundation. It is critical to update Newman Catholic High School to meet the needs of this generation of students and the next.

Annual Fund Drive Summary

The Newman Catholic Schools Annual Fund is a yearly program developed to attract contributions, to help offset the costs of a Newman Catholic School education and day-to-day operations.

The goal of the NCS Annual Fund Drive is to raise funds to help support programs throughout ALL of our schools. Parents, alumni, alumni parents, and friends all invest in the Annual Fund. Currently tuition and fees cover approximately 39% of the operating budget, and parish support provides 33%, resulting in the extreme importance of additional development and other fundraising efforts to cover the remaining 28%. The success of this fund drive is essential for us to continue to meet the needs of our students and to help keep the cost of a Newman Catholic School education manageable.

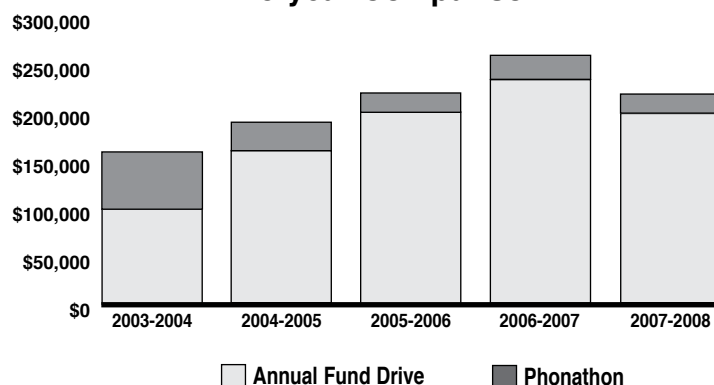

Education Commission

The governance of Newman Catholic Schools is a consultative structure made up of an Education Commission, whose membership includes each supporting parish pastor (including the Dean), as well as one appointed representative from each of the parishes. The pastor and parish representatives are the communicative link between the parishes and schools. Standing committee chairpersons are also a part of this group, as is the President of the Newman Catholic Schools. The commission is charged with determining policies for our schools and developing the budget. It is, however, advisory in nature to the President, who - in consultation with the local Dean, the Diocesan Director of Catholic Schools, and the Bishop - makes the final decisions regarding the school system and its operation.

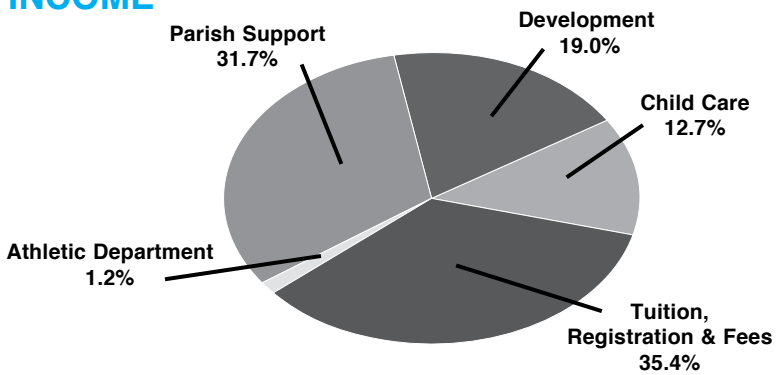

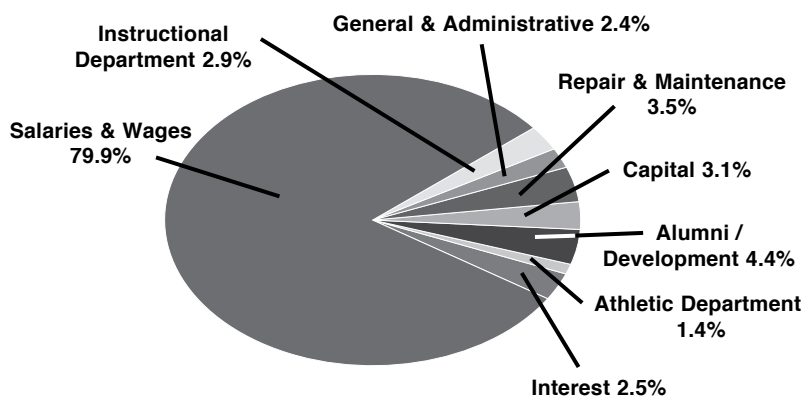
