OLD BUSINESS

A motion was made by Ken Teeters and seconded by Paul Knoblock to approve the March 10, 2010 meeting minutes. The motion was approved.

FINANCIAL *(Bob Krause)*

No detailed account has been received from the central office. Account balances are: Checking account balance of \$34,102.56 and money market account balance of \$40,605.12. An athletic field payment of \$30,000 for 2010 will be made this summer. Budget projections should be on the upcoming reports.

GUS MACKER-June 19 & 20, 2010 *(Danny Rozwadowski)*

Dale reported that in the past few weeks, Gus Macker brochures were distributed at a Great Northwest 8th grade tournament in Stevens Point and a 6th grade tournament at Wausau West. Danny is meeting this evening with Elite Carriers regarding trucking for the tournament. Contracts have been signed with Buffalo Wild Wing's - \$5,000, and Siam Gardens - \$2,500, as food vendors on the Newman Grounds. The booster club will also have a food stand on the Newman grounds serving Pepsi beverage products and French fries. Coach Michlig volunteered the football team to assist with running the stand. Coach Peksa volunteered to run the stand. Fourteen courts and the dream court will be located on the Newman grounds. High school and adult courts will be located on the Wausau West grounds. Randy Pagel and Paul Baumann will coordinate walking and motorized transportation lanes between Newman and Wausau West. Gus Busters are needed. All contracts ended last year so it has been a busy off -season. Sound from the main stage will be transmitted to the Newman grounds. A Gus Macker kick-off will be held in early May at County Market featuring food and a radio station will be present. Additional committee meetings will be held in the next two months.

FACILITIES *(Jim Lemke)*

Dale reported the field renovation was on schedule last fall and because of the early start is now ahead of schedule.

CABIN FEVER-April 10, 2010 *(Dale Skrzypchak)*

This is the 4th annual. It has been very financially successful to date with net income of over \$35,000. Need members to attend. Tickets will be available at the door. There will be a number of raffles and over 50 silent auction items.

Dale reported that he had met with Jan Klosinski regarding these items. Jan stated that NCS is not in a financial position at this time to commit to these projects. She personally feels they are both very important. It was noted by Dale that \$20,000 was designated for the bleachers at the NCS auction.

ELECTIONS (*Dale Skrzypchak*)

Elections for the positions of chairperson and secretary will be held after the May 2010 meeting. Bob Krause and Al Romportl will be contacting booster club members for their interest in running for these positions.

NEW BUSINESS

1. The senior awards banquet will be held on Saturday, May 8th. A Newman graduate, Bob Gillespie, will be the guest speaker. A motion was made by Romey Wagner and seconded by Ken Teeters to have the booster club pay for a motel room for the speaker, not to exceed \$150. The motion was approved.
2. A cook out for spring athletes, their coaches and parents, will be held before the next booster club meeting on May 5th. Dinner will be served at 5 p.m. Help is needed. Paul Knoblock, Randy Pagel, Mike Bandoch, Paula Szydel and Romey Wagner volunteered. John Pozorski will donate the ground meat. All booster club members are invited to attend.
3. Help is needed for the Gus Macker kick-off at County Market. Ken Teeters, Bob Krause and Paula Szydel.
4. Dale stated that a policy is in place regarding the needs of NCS sports. The first step is to contact the athletic director to have items budgeted. The second step is to contact the booster club.
