

Newman Catholic High School Senior Scholarships

A tentative list of scholarships based on those awarded in 2005.

Remember there are other scholarships available, not just the Newman Catholic scholarships.

Abby Bank: \$500 scholarship to a senior planning to further their education in the field of business or finance.

Elda Bonvincin Scholarship: \$850 scholarship to a senior who excels at and has taken at least 4 years of a foreign language and plans to take a foreign language while at college. Would like to student to be pursuing a field related to foreign language.

Wausau Breakfast Optimist Club Scholarship: Two \$500 scholarship to student planning to attend post-secondary school, in top 50% of class.

Colonial Manor Resident Scholarship: \$200 scholarship to senior planning to pursue some aspect of a health related career. Health Care volunteer work, especially at Colonial Manor would be beneficial.

Pat Condon Memorial Scholarship: Two \$500 scholarships to seniors who represent hard work and good attendance. Requires a 300 word or less essay on your activities both inside and outside of Newman and your goals for the future.

County Market Scholarship: \$250 scholarship to senior employed at County Market. Prefer 3.0 or higher GPA and plan to pursue post-secondary education.

Mark H. Dreyer Scholarship: \$625 (renewable) scholarship to senior to attend UW-System school. Demonstrate financial need.

Wausau Elkette's Scholarship: \$250 scholarship to female senior planning to enroll at any 2or 4-year college. Prefer service or helping profession pursuit. Academic improvement, personal character and extra curricular activities.

Wausau Festival of Arts Scholarship: \$350 scholarship to senior who demonstrates excellence in artistic achievement. Must have taken 2+ years of art. Must be willing to display 2-3 examples of artwork at the Center for Visual Arts.

Helke Funeral Home Scholarship: \$200 scholarship to senior in the top 1/3 of class demonstrating financial need.

Tyrone Kleinhans Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000 scholarship to graduating senior. Must have 2.8+ GPA and submit a 300-word or less essay on "How my involvement with academics, athletics, and community service has made a difference to me and others". Please cite examples of leadership, community service, and contribution to your school.

Joseph C. Kucirek Memorial Law Scholarship: \$1,000 scholarship to senior with 3.0+ GPA planning to pursue a law degree/career. Must submit an essay (1-2 pages) on why applying for the scholarship and pursuing a law career.

Marathon County Blood Bank Scholarship: \$250.00 scholarship to senior that is planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college, priority to those selecting a medical major.

Marathon County Medical Alliance Scholarship: \$500 scholarship to senior pursuing education/career in the health field. Must have 3.0+ GPA, not for 2004.

Harvey J. Nelson Trust Scholarship: \$2,500 (\$1,250 per semester) scholarship for post-secondary education. Senior demonstrating overall academic excellence, extra curricular activity and community involvement.

Robert J. Neugebauer Scholarship: \$500 scholarship to senior planning to attend a four-year college. 3.0+ GPA. Demonstrate financial need. \$150 presented to senior planning to attend post-secondary school. Demonstrate financial need.

River Valley State Bank: \$500 scholarship based on financial need.

Wausau Noon Optimist Scholarship: \$500 scholarship to senior planning to attend UWMC or NTC. Demonstrates service club commitment, good character and civic responsibility. Beneficial if parent is an Optimist.

South Area Business Association Scholarship: \$500 scholarship to senior who works for or parent works for SABA member (see Mrs. LeVeque for a list). Must plan to pursue 1+ year post-secondary education.

Aspirus Volunteers Scholarship: \$750 scholarship to graduating senior who is involved in volunteer activities at the hospital, is reliable with high integrity and good academic standing.

Wausau Lyric Choir Scholarship: \$150 scholarship to graduation senior who plans to pursue a career in vocal music. This would not necessarily require a major in vocal music.

Wausau Woman's Club Scholarship: \$350 scholarship to senior pursuing a degree in nursing or other health related field.
