FINANCIAL REPORT (*Randy Gabriel/MJN*)

Currently for Unrestricted Cash we have \$9,006.46.

MJN handed out Ave Maria Fund Family information provided by Jeff Isaacson at Peoples. The club agreed that the information could be reviewed at home, and any questions could be sent to MJN.

A couple initial questions were:

CONCESSIONS (*Al Romportl*)

Basketball games are to start next week, and Al was checking to see if the schedule was setup for concessions. Paul Michlig confirmed after the meeting that workers were assigned. We discussed removing some of the concession menu items like walking tacos that are labor intensive for prepping, and don't have a great response on sales, so those will be discontinued. The club discussed new potential menu additions like corn dogs, pizza rolls, chicken nuggets or tenders. We currently don't have a good way to prep those options, so an air fryer was suggested. MJN has an air fryer, and will drop off at NC for testing the potential new menu items.

ALUMINUM CAN RECYCLING (*MJN*)

The can trailer is nearing the full mark and will need to be taken in again. The biggest issue with the trailer is that there is currently not a top to keep the cans in during transit. Rod Samuels measured the top, and found a bungee cord type net at Fleet Farm, that would be an option for keeping the cans in. The price was around \$25, so we will purchase the net to aid in the transport of the cans.
