BC FUNDS REQUESTS (*MJN*)

A request was made by Paula Damask for \$500 for the annual Senior Party that we have contributed to yearly. MJN made a motion to approve the funds for the senior class, it was seconded by Andy Cummings and all in attendance voted yes to the request.

A request was made by Dan Sullivan for funds to cover the busing for our Middle School softball program which was not budgeted originally for this school year. The club had a discussion that this is not something that we usually do, since it is usually a function of the Administration for these types of funds, but would help out with this as a 1 time only situation. The MS Softball Team will have 6 away games, but Steve Jankowski let us know that we would really only need busing for 3 of the games, since 3 are away, but in town. The estimated cost of the busing is was roughly \$1000 for the 6 games, and should really come in closer to the \$500 dollar range. Mike Bandoch made a motion to approve up to \$1000 for the MS Softball Team busing, which was seconded Ken Teeters, all in attendance voted yes to the request.

Another request was made by the 7th grade basketball team for tournament fees of \$270 to help prep for their state tournament appearance. Marty Krach made a motion to approve \$270, and it was seconded by Mike Bandoch, all in attendance voted in favor of the request.

Motion to adjourn by Mike Bandoch and seconded by Steve Jankowski.
