Mr. Kevin McCutcheon graduated from Newman Catholic High School in 1976. During his time at Newman, Mr. McCutcheon became student council president, a A student, and was later accepted to play football as a "walk on" at the University of Georgia. After graduation, he married his high school sweetheart, Chris (Kuehlman) McCutcheon.

The early 70's marked the last months of the Vietnam conflict, and Mr. McCutcheon chose to join the marines and spend 32 years of his life serving our country.
